## UTILITY WORKER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Position requires a High School Diploma or GED.

Must have and maintain a valid Alabama Driver's License and a good driving record.

A Physical is required as well as a Drug/Alcohol test.

Must be physically able to accomplish requirements of the job, including bending, walking, standing, climbing, pulling, digging, lifting to (50) pounds, and lifting up over head heavy objects and more as the job requires.

Assist with the installation and/or repair of Natural Gas, Water, Sewer Lines, and etc.
This also includes when it is required to work in sewer-wastewater.

Required to be on call one week a month on a rotating basis.

Follow any and all instructions given by the Superintendent and report any existing or pending problems to him.

Responsible for the care and operation of the vehicle assigned to him/her, making sure vehicles are kept clean and reporting any problems with equipment.

Be flexible to work in any area of the Utilities and perform duties in a workman-like manner as directed by the Superintendent.

Maintain a neat personal appearance, being professional in the duties of his/her duties, promote good public relations, and uphold the public service of the utilities and his/her co-workers at all times.

All additional duties as required or assigned.

All permanent Service Personnel will be required to attend necessary training as set forth by the Superintendent. Training for certification will include classes for Water/Wastewater/Natural Gas Operators.

The Superintendent will conduct an evaluation after three (3) months' time.
